Parent Conflict Resolution Process**

When a parent at Marco Island Charter Middle School has a conflict to resolve, the following procedure must be followed:

1. First contact your child's teacher if the conflict is a student discipline or classroom issue. If satisfaction is not reached, contact Mrs. Marcoux, the Assistant Principal at marcouma@collierschools.com or call 377-3206. If satisfaction is not reached at the Assistant Principal level, contact Mr. Abounader, the Principal/CEO at abounage@collierschools.com or call 377-3200. Finally, if the conflict is still not resolved, contact Mr. Tarik Ayasun the President of the School Board at micsboardpresident@gmail.com

2. If the conflict is a transportation issue contact the transportation department at Collier County Schools at Transportation@collierschools.com. If satisfaction is not reached, contact Mrs. Marcoux, the Assistant Principal at marcouma@collierschools.com or call 377-3206.
