- To develop students abilities to respond to texts they read

Teacher Instructions

1. Form a series of three (or more) generalized statements related to the passage of text you wish students to read. Use this template to write them down and make a copy for each student.
2. Prior to reading, ask students to consider each generalization and use this worksheet to indicate their level of agreement or disagreement with the generalization.
3. As students read the passage, they should take notes on the issues presented by the generalizations.
4. After reading, students should evaluate their original marks to determine if their level of agreement or disagreement has changed. They should record why they continue to stand by or abandon their original impressions.

- Follow the anticipation guide with an explanatory writing or discussion activity.
