



## Quick Write/Quick Draw

Quick Write/Quick Draw is a literacy strategy that gives students the opportunity to reflect on their learning.

### Instructions:

1. Provide students with a copy of the Quick Write/Quick Draw sheet (see next page). For younger students, you may want to use a blank sheet of paper instead.
2. Ask students to write and draw everything they remember from their experience. Provide some prompts by asking the following questions:
  - How did you feel?
  - What did you think about?
  - What did you learn?
  - What did you like the most?
  - What did you not like?
  - What surprised you?
  - What made you curious?
  - What was the coolest thing you remember?
3. Work together to brainstorm a list of vocabulary words from the experience; have students record their favorite words at the bottom of the sheet.
